

ORDINANCE NO. 38
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON SEWER AND WATER
CONNECTIONS OUTSIDE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES.

The following was moved by Councilperson Thomas, second by Councilperson Koppleberger:

THE CITY OF ITHACA ORDAINS:

SECTION 38-120: LIMITATIONS OF SEWER AND WATER CONNECTIONS OUTSIDE
MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES.

- (1) City Policy: The City of Ithaca has established a policy to not provide city services without standing agreements, water and sanitary sewer services shall be considered the same. City of Ithaca water and sanitary sewer services shall only be provided to property owners within its boundaries. Property owners outside the City requesting service shall be required to annex to the City or enter into a 425 agreement to access services.
- (2) Limitation on the Obligation to Provide Service: There shall be a limit to the City's provision of sewer and/or water services. There are limits established by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality that affect sewer treatment and water supply considerations that have bearing. City Council shall consider additional requests for City services on a case-by-case basis.
- (3) Existing Water and Sewer Services outside the Municipal Boundaries: The City shall continue to provide water service to properties outside its boundaries located on St. Charles Road which began before the date of this ordinance.

This Ordinance was introduced on June 3, 2014.

This Ordinance is passed, ordained and ordered published by action of the City Council on this 17th day of June 2014.
