The Ithaca City Council will be hosting a Town Hall meeting for City of Ithaca residents at the Alice M. Schafer Council Chamber located inside City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the city's policing services, how policing in Ithaca looks in the future, and the financing of such services. If public attendance is greater than the chamber capacity, we will move to the Community Center. Currently, the City of Ithaca contracts with the Gratiot County Sheriff's Department for policing. Our residents pay a millage rate of 1.5 which raised \$117,718.96 this past year. The current police contract costs just under \$500,000 for that same year. The shortfall has historically been covered using general fund dollars, which limits capital improvement projects. Inevitably, there will be a time when the city will have to ask the residents for a larger millage rate for policing costs.

Thank you for taking the time to share your thoughts, whether it is at the town hall or through the questionnaire. We appreciate you all and look forward to growing an even stronger community for our future here in Ithaca.
